**Withholding Periods:** DO NOT apply later than one day before harvest.

If using with any other product refer to the companion product withholding period on that label.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

Apply in mid winter when trees or vines are dormant. Spray coverage; A liberal application of the product is required to ensure complete coverage of all eggs.

### MIXING INSTRUCTIONS

Pour the required amount of water into the mixing tank and while agitating add the required amount of VICOL WINTER OIL. When using in combination with other pesticides, mix the pesticide first according to the manufacturers instructions, then add VICOL WINTER OIL last. Maintain continuous agitation while spraying.

### GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS (cont)

#### Protection of Wildlife, Fish, Crustacea and Environment

Do not contaminate streams, rivers or watercourses with the chemical or used containers.

#### COMPATIBILITY

VICOL WINTER OIL should not be tank mixed with any herbicide, insecticide or fungicide except in strict accordance with the manufacturers' instructions.

#### STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN.

Store in the closed, original container in a cool, well ventilated area. Do not store for prolonged periods in direct sunlight.

Triple-rinse containers before disposal. Add rinsings to spray tank. Do not dispose of undiluted chemicals on site. If recycling, replace cap and return clean containers to recycler or designated collection point. If an approved waste management facility is not available, bury the empty packaging 500mm below the surface in a disposal pit specifically marked and set up for this purpose clear of waterways, desirable vegetation and tree roots, in compliance with relevant Local, State or Territory government regulations. Do not burn empty containers and product. For Refillable / Returnable (1000 L) Containers: Empty contents fully into application equipment. Close all valves and return to point of supply for refill or storage.

Spill Management: In the event of spillage absorb onto sand or chemical absorbent. Remove residue with detergent and hot water. Dispose of by normal waste disposal methods conforming to local authority codes.

### SAFETY DIRECTIONS

Avoid inhalation of spray mists. Will irritate the eyes. May irritate the skin. Avoid contact with eyes and skin. When opening the container and preparing the spray, wear elbow length PVC gloves and face shield or goggles. Use a mask when spraying in combination with other chemicals and refer to their safety directions. If product in eyes wash out immediately with water. Wash hands after use. After each day's use, wash gloves and face shield or goggles.

#### FIRST AID
